- Use a range of teaching techniques and activities to share that knowledge with subsequent learners

How will this course help me achieve my teaching goals?

- Providing me with the principles and objectives of teaching English to speakers of other languages.
- Building my knowledge of the skills and concepts of the language required for teaching English.
- Providing me with ideas for teaching activities and ways of using equipment and resources in a classroom situation.
- Encouraging me to be the most efficient and effective ESOL teacher I can be.
